---

Terre Blanche is a white Rhone blend comprised of Roussanne and Viognier grapes grown on the Westside of Paso Robles in the acclaimed Denner Vineyard.

## VINIFICATION

---

Fermented in French oak barrels, 15% new. Stirred the lees throughout malolactic fermentation. The wine went through 50% malolactic fermentation and was bottled after 8 months in barrel.

## TASTING NOTES

---

Nectarine, rose petal, marzipan, blanched almonds, anise and papaya, followed by granite/slate notes, jasmine and casaba melon. Great structure and a bright finish.
